What do you invest in?

You will meet around 60 companies, including:

- **Vestas:** The company designs, manufactures, installs, develops and services wind energy and hybrid projects around the world.
- **Lenzing:** The company transforms wood and wood chips from controlled and sustainable forestry into high quality products. It produces sustainable consumables or fabrics from pulp and its registered brands include Tencel and Lyocel.
- **Schneider Electric:** The company is one of the leading players in automating and digitizing processes and manufacturing to reduce production costs and make the process more efficient.

It also includes traditional companies such as Visa, Nike, Microsoft, ASML, Walt Disney and Mercedes Benz. These are companies that are very high on the corporate responsibility ranking and are therefore an integral part of this fund.

Who is the fund intended for?

The fund is designed for retail clients with basic investment knowledge who are aware of the risks associated with investing in conventional investment funds and their attitude to risk is: **Very dynamic**. Which means that the client prefers the potential for return even at the cost of significant fluctuations in the value of the investment. He/she is aware that the value of the investment may be several years below the initial value and expects a return significantly higher than the return on regular bank deposits.
